- Need 4 volunteers per shift: 3 lot monitors and 1 entrance monitor at BMI. Detailed job descriptions will be provided when you sign up.
- 35 total number of spaces available at Women's Resource Center, 9 spaces available at BMI.
- \$20 parking fee per car per entry -- cash and credit cards accepted.
